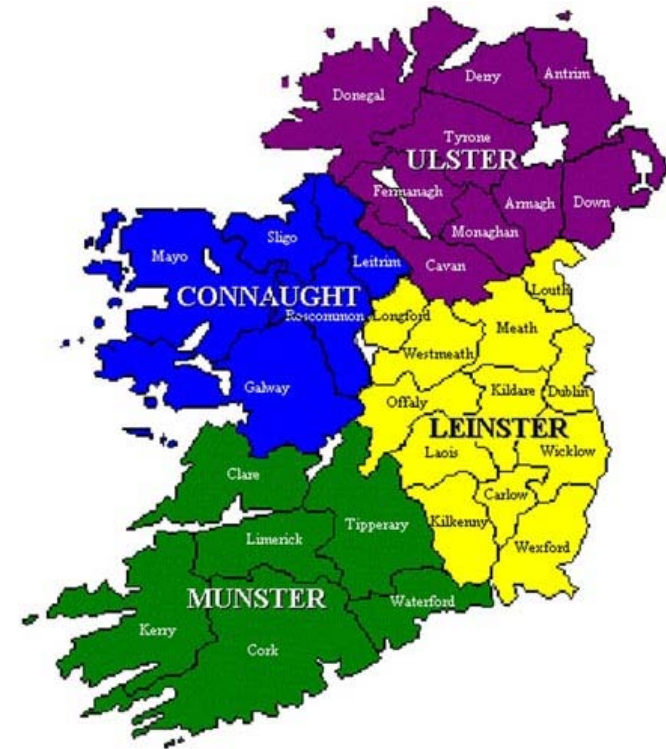

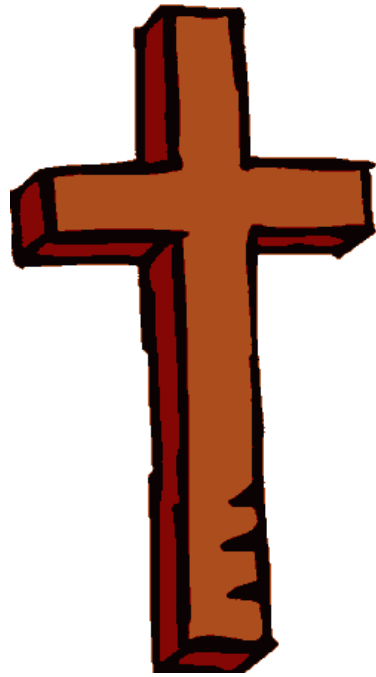

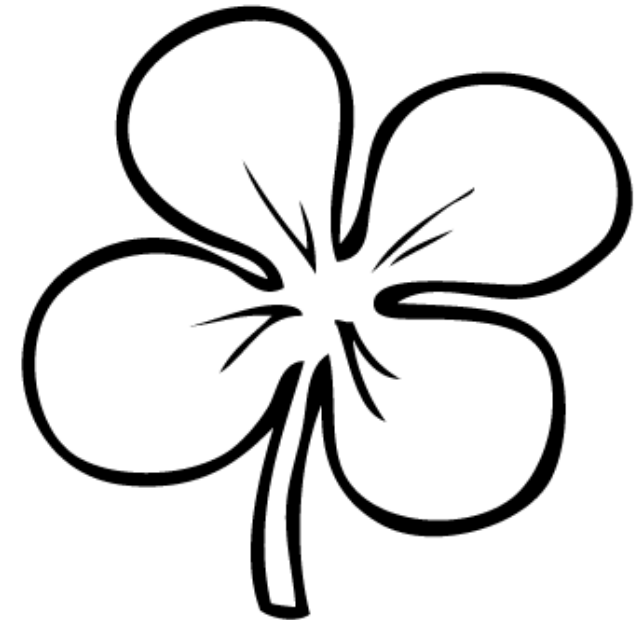
March 17 is Saint Patrick's Day.
